Congressional Budget Office BASELINE June 2024

Today, the Congressional Budget Office (CBO) released its updated budget projections for fiscal years **(FY) 2024-2034**. This CBO baseline is the last baseline update under Biden's Four Years of Fiscal Failure. Since Biden took office, 10-year deficit projections have grown by <u>**80 percent**</u>. Similarly, deficit projections for FY2024 have ballooned to <u>111.6 percent</u> higher than previously anticipated.
