## <u>Consumer Confidence:</u> <u>Chairman Arrington Statement on</u> <u>September Report</u>

**WASHINGTON, D.C.** – Today, The Conference Board released its <u>report</u> on the Consumer Confidence Index for September 2024. The report showed that overall consumer sentiment <u>declined sharply in September to 98.7</u> from an upwardly revised 105.6 in August, demonstrating that Americans continue to worry about their financial futures. <u>This was the largest decline in Consumer</u> <u>Confidence since August 2021.</u> Consumer Confidence remains well below pre-Covid levels.

### CHAIRMAN ARRINGTON ON CONSUMER CONFIDENCE

# House Budget Committee Chairman Jodey Arrington (R-TX) released the following statement on Consumer Confidence for September:

"Today's report exposes the truth of the matter: Americans continue to distrust the Biden-Harris economy. Despite the long-awaited rate reduction, consumers remain wary about their ability to afford basic necessities, with consumer sentiment experiencing its largest drop since August 2021.

*Further, due to the economic pain unleashed by the Biden-Harris spending spree, less than 20 percent of American consumers expect their incomes to rise.* 

With an almost 25 percent increase in the unemployment level, the threat of a recession still lies ahead, and consumers are struggling to afford food and



health care because of the Biden-Harris Administration's reckless and unbridled spending spree.

Working Americans want real results from Washington that will lower prices, increase their paychecks, and provide better opportunities for their families."

### THE "WHY"

According to the latest data from the University of Michigan, the share of consumers who expect no real income growth in the coming five years now **stands** at the **highest on record**.

Since Biden-Harris took office, <u>the cost of goods and services has increased</u> <u>nearly 20 percent</u>. Families spend over \$<u>17,000 more annually</u> just to maintain the same standard of living they enjoyed before this Administration, underscoring the country's dire fiscal future.

Under the Biden-Harris Administration, **unchecked spending** and burdening regulations have suffocated American businesses. <u>Consumer confidence</u> **peaked in October 2018 at 137.9** before the Biden-Harris's policies choked the economy.

The House Budget Committee is committed to <u>Sounding the Alarm</u> on the Biden-Harris spending spree and reversing the mismanagement of taxpayer funds.
