Oversight Task Force Releases Report: *“Looking at the Numbers: Biden’s Big Government”*

WASHINGTON, D.C. – Today, the House Budget Committee’s Oversight Task Force, chaired by Rep. Jack Bergman (R-MI), released a report, “[Looking at the Numbers: Biden’s Big Government](#),” contextualizing how much the Federal government’s spending habits have grown in just three short years.

Key Facts:

- Since taking office, President Biden “has overseen over **\$11 trillion in spending** – more than **\$1.5 trillion** of which has been done unilaterally through various executive actions and rulemaking, marking a clear circumvention of Congress.”
- Within that same time period, “projected ten-year outlays have increased from **\$61.2 trillion** to **\$80.1 trillion**, an increase of **\$18.9 trillion** or **30.8 percent**. This translates to a **10 percent jump in outlays** as percent of GDP.”
- These increases are particularly evident at the Department level – compared to January 2021:
 - Projected ten-year outlays for the **Environmental Protection Agency** have increased **163.9 percent**.
 - Projected ten-year outlays for the **Department of Commerce** have increased **136.2 percent**.
 - Projected ten-year outlays for the **Department of Treasury** have increased **87.2 percent**.
