

Debt Tracking Report for July 22nd, 2024

The gross national debt is currently \$34.95 trillion. This equates to:

- \$104,343 per person
- **\$265,882** per household
- \$483,176 per child

When President Biden took office total gross debt was \$27.75 trillion, meaning he has increased the national debt by \$7.19 trillion. This equates to:

- \$21,480 more debt per person
- \$54,735 more debt per household
- \$99,468 more debt per child

The rate of debt accumulation during the Biden Administration has equaled:

- \$171 billion in new debt per month
- \$5.6 billion in new debt per day
- **\$234 million** in new debt per hour
- \$3.9 million in new debt per minute
- \$65,101 in new debt per second

The debt one year ago was \$32.59 trillion, meaning that the debt has increased by \$2.36 trillion over the past 12 months. This rate of increase equates to:

- \$196 billion in new debt per month
- **\$6.5 billion** in new debt per day
- **\$269 million** in new debt per hour
- **\$4.5 million** in new debt per minute
- \$74,678 in new debt per second
