

## Debt Tracking Report for June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2024

The gross national debt is currently \$34.61 trillion. This equates to:

- \$103,844 per person
- **\$263,325** per household
- \$478,528 per child

When President Biden took office total gross debt was \$27.75 trillion, meaning he has increased the national debt by \$6.86 trillion. This equates to:

- \$20,577 more debt per person
- \$52,178 more debt per household
- **\$94,820** more debt per child

The rate of debt accumulation during the Biden Administration has equaled:

- \$170 billion in new debt per month
- \$5.6 billion in new debt per day
- \$232 million in new debt per hour
- \$3.9 million in new debt per minute
- **\$64,532** in new debt per second

The debt one year ago was \$31.46 trillion, meaning that the debt has increased by \$3.15 trillion over the past 12 months. This rate of increase equates to:

- \$262 billion in new debt per month
- \$8.6 billion in new debt per day
- \$359 million in new debt per hour
- **\$6.0** million in new debt per minute
- **\$99,753** in new debt per second
