

## Debt Tracking Report for May 28th, 2024

The gross national debt is currently \$34.58 trillion. This equates to:

- \$103,746 per person
- **\$263,076** per household
- \$478,076 per child

When President Biden took office total gross debt was \$27.75 trillion, meaning he has increased the national debt by \$6.83 trillion. This equates to:

- \$20,479 more debt per person
- \$51,929 more debt per household
- \$94,368 more debt per child

The rate of debt accumulation during the Biden Administration has equaled:

- \$170.63 billion in new debt per month
- \$5.6 billion in new debt per day
- \$233.29 million in new debt per hour
- \$3.89 million in new debt per minute
- $\cdot$  \$64,804 in new debt per second

The debt one year ago was \$31.46 trillion, meaning that the debt has increased by \$3.11 trillion over the past 12 months. This rate of increase equates to:

- \$259.43 billion in new debt per month
- **\$8.53 billion** in new debt per day
- \$355.38 million in new debt per hour
- \$5.92 million in new debt per minute
- \$98,717 in new debt per second
