

Debt Tracking Report for November 12th, 2024

The gross national debt is currently \$35.94 trillion. This equates to:

- \$107,321 per person
- **\$273,472** per household
- **\$496,969** per child

When President Biden and Vice President Harris took office total gross debt was \$27.75 trillion, meaning he has increased the national debt by \$8.19 trillion. This equates to:

- \$24,459 more debt per person
- \$62,325 more debt per household
- \$113,261 more debt per child

The rate of debt accumulation during the Biden-Harris Administration has equaled:

- \$179 billion in new debt per month
- **\$5.9 billion** in new debt per day
- **\$245 million** in new debt per hour
- **\$4.1 million** in new debt per minute
- \$68,111 in new debt per second

The debt one year ago was \$33.72 trillion, meaning that the debt has increased by \$2.22 trillion over the past 12 months. This rate of increase equates to:

- \$185 billion in new debt per month
- **\$6.1 billion** in new debt per day
- \$253 million in new debt per hour
- **\$4.2 million** in new debt per minute
- \$70,409 in new debt per second
