

Debt Tracking Report for October 15th, 2024

The gross national debt is currently \$35.68 trillion. This equates to:

- \$106,536 per person
- **\$271,472** per household
- \$493,333 per child

When President Biden and Vice President Harris took office total gross debt was \$27.75 trillion, meaning he has increased the national debt by \$7.93 trillion. This equates to:

- \$23,674 more debt per person
- \$60,325 more debt per household
- **\$109,626** more debt per child

The rate of debt accumulation during the Biden-Harris Administration has equaled:

- \$177 billion in new debt per month
- \$5.8 billion in new debt per day
- **\$242 million** in new debt per hour
- **\$4.0 million** in new debt per minute
- \$67,278 in new debt per second

The debt one year ago was \$33.55 trillion, meaning that the debt has increased by \$2.13 trillion over the past 12 months. This rate of increase equates to:

- \$176 billion in new debt per month
- \$5.8 billion in new debt per day
- **\$243 million** in new debt per hour
- **\$4.1 million** in new debt per minute
- \$67,554 in new debt per second
