

Debt Tracking Report for October 22nd, 2024

The gross national debt is currently \$35.77 trillion. This equates to:

- **\$106,802** per person
- **\$272,150** per household
- **\$494,565** per child

When President Biden and Vice President Harris took office total gross debt was \$27.75 trillion, meaning he has increased the national debt by \$8.02 trillion. This equates to:

- \$23,940 more debt per person
- \$61,003 more debt per household
- **\$110,858** more debt per child

The rate of debt accumulation during the Biden-Harris Administration has equaled:

- \$178 billion in new debt per month
- \$5.8 billion in new debt per day
- **\$244 million** in new debt per hour
- **\$4.1 million** in new debt per minute
- \cdot \$67,687 in new debt per second

The debt one year ago was \$33.63 trillion, meaning that the debt has increased by \$2.14 trillion over the past 12 months. This rate of increase equates to:

- \$178 billion in new debt per month
- **\$5.9 billion** in new debt per day
- \$244 million in new debt per hour
- **\$4.1 million** in new debt per minute
- \$67,876 in new debt per second
