## Debt Tracking Report for September 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2024

The gross national debt is currently **\$35.28 trillion**. This equates to:

- **\$105,340** per person
- **\$268,422** per household
- **\$487,791** per child

When President Biden and Vice President Harris took office total gross debt was **\$27.75 trillion**, meaning he has increased the national debt by **\$7.53 trillion**. This equates to:

- \$22,477 more debt per person
- \$57,275 more debt per household
- \$104,083 more debt per child

The rate of debt accumulation during the Biden-Harris Administration has equaled:

- \$173 billion in new debt per month
- **\$5.7 billion** in new debt per day
- **\$237 million** in new debt per hour
- **\$4.0 million** in new debt per minute
- **\$65,906** in new debt per second

The debt one year ago was **\$32.86 trillion**, meaning that the debt has increased by **\$2.42 trillion** over the past 12 months. This rate of increase equates to:

- **\$202 billion** in new debt per month
- **\$6.6 billion** in new debt per day
- **\$277 million** in new debt per hour
- **\$4.6 million** in new debt per minute
- \$76,843 in new debt per second
