

## Debt Tracking Report for September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2024

The gross national debt is currently \$35.35 trillion. This equates to:

- \$105,536 per person
- **\$268,923** per household
- \$488,701 per child

When President Biden and Vice President Harris took office total gross debt was \$27.75 trillion, meaning he has increased the national debt by \$7.59 trillion. This equates to:

- \$22,673 more debt per person
- \$57,776 more debt per household
- \$104,993 more debt per child

The rate of debt accumulation during the Biden-Harris Administration has equaled:

- \$174 billion in new debt per month
- \$5.7 billion in new debt per day
- **\$238 million** in new debt per hour
- **\$4.0 million** in new debt per minute
- \$66,182 in new debt per second

The debt one year ago was \$32.89 trillion, meaning that the debt has increased by \$2.45 trillion over the past 12 months. This rate of increase equates to:

- \$205 billion in new debt per month
- **\$6.7 billion** in new debt per day
- $\cdot$  \$280 million in new debt per hour
- **\$4.7 million** in new debt per minute
- \$77,845 in new debt per second
